Part of Crealdé's Long Range Plan includes building its emergency fund—a cash reserve that helps to keep the organization financially nimble and strong. Just like a household reserve, the funds are invested, only to be used for:

- Unforeseen expenses or cash shortfalls that occur due to factors outside of the organization's control.
- Replacement or repair of equipment or property.
- Unexpected opportunities that arise, such as expanded programming and new partnerships.

Crealdé's Board of Directors oversees the withdrawal of monies from the Reserve Fund the fund is held Seacoast Bank, a long-time business partner.
