MARIE ORBAN PAINTING AND DRAWING SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM



The Marie Orban Scholarship for painting and drawing students, was established in the year 2020, in memory of beloved faculty member and friend, through a privately funded memorial fund. This Painting and Drawing scholarship opportunity at Crealdé School of Art, was created to support the education of an emerging artist with financial need. This annual, \$1,000.00 scholarship enables an adult student to take painting and drawing classes and workshops in all five of Crealdé's sessions per calendar year. A Crealdé faculty member must recommend applicants.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Crealdé must receive application materials no later than October 15 to ensure consideration for the following year. Applicants will be notified no later than December 15.
- The applicant must be at least 18 years of age at the time of the application.
- The applicant must be a member of Crealdé School of Art.
- The scholarship funds must be used towards classes and workshops in Crealdé's painting and drawing program.
- The funds for our scholarships are generously provided by private donors. In order for the School to continue
 receiving the annual donation, the applicant is committing to utilizing the full scholarship amount by 12/31 of the
 calendar year following the award notification.
- The applicant must submit:
 - 1. Resume or list of Crealdé classes attended.
 - 2. A letter of artistic intent.
 - 3. A statement of income demonstrating financial need.
 - 4. Minimum of five examples of original work.
 - 5. A signed agreement.
 - 6. A self-addressed envelope that is large enough, with sufficient postage, to mail back all applicant's materials.
